Dear Later Family, I am so deeply sorry for your loss. I only just learned of Bob's passing, and my heart is heavy. I first began seeing him as a patient in 1988, and throughout all these years, he was a constant source of comfort, kindness, and strength. He had a way of making people feel completely at ease, even in their most vulnerable moments. He delivered my daughter in 1995, and I'll never forget how he had me come to the hospital the night before for a procedure—something he had only done once—when insurance wouldn't approve it, he simply said, "Come in anyway, it will all work out."
