Ronald Lloyd Hammer of Salt Lake City, Utah passed away peacefully in his home after a battle with metastatic prostate cancer on Thursday, January 25, 2018. Ron was born February 18, 1940 in Salt Lake City to Lloyd and Theora Pugmire Hammer. He graduated from South High School and was a University of Utah Alumni, where he served as an ASUU Student Body Officer and a proud lifelong member of Pi Kappa Alpha (Once a Pike, Always a Pike!). Ron married Judy Elkins on February 21, 1968 in the Salt Lake Temple. They were looking forward to celebrating 50 years of marriage this year. He was an active member of the LDS Church, having served in the Central German Mission as a young man, and later on a church service mission at the Palmer Court Branch with his sweetheart as his companion.
