Our loving husband, father, son and friend, Richard Scott Fowles, age 59, of Sandy, Utah passed away of liver cancer on September 4, 2015. He was born February 20, 1956, in Salt Lake City, Utah, to Richard Matthews and Shirley Rae Fehr Fowles.

Rick spent his younger childhood years growing up in Bountiful, Utah and then moved to Scottsdale, Arizona at age 10. He was very active in sports, and especially loved playing baseball and football for Saguaro High School. Upon graduating from high school, he served a full-time mission for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints in the Ireland, Belfast Mission. He served as a Branch President while there. After his return, he attended Brigham Young University and the University of Utah majoring in Communications. He married Karin Kapp Fowles on May 12, 1982, in the Idaho Falls Temple, and they made their home in Sandy, Utah.

Rick was employed as a Program Management Director at Novell, Inc. for 27 years and served on a variety of committees. He enjoyed Harleys, airplanes, tinkering with cars, music, photography, reading, studying and a good sense of humor. He possessed a firm testimony of Jesus Christ and a rich knowledge of the gospel and its principles.

Rick is survived by his wife Karin, son Scott Richard Fowles, daughter, Jennica Lynn Marriott (Nick) and Jonathan Timothy Fowles.
