Amanda L. Evans died on Friday, March 8th in her home in Bridgeport from complications of heart disease. She was born in Murray, UT on May 10, 1977 to R. Mont and Cheryl (Sherry) M Evans.

With a daunting intellect, she excelled at whatever she put her mind to, but her greatest accomplishment was the impact she had on the lives of all who knew her.

Amanda's potential was never fully realized, and the world is a darker place without her.
