



## Calvin Boyd Smith

Calvin Boyd Smith of Sandy, UT passed away on November 11, 2017. Calvin was born the fourth child of his parents Don Samuel Smith and Adella Struhs Smith September 24, 1923 in Rexburg, Idaho. His early years were spent in Idaho, later relocating with his parents to SLC. Calvin served in the Navy during WWII.
