Anton T. "Tony" Clawson, Jr., age 81, passed away in South Jordan, Utah on January 19, 2018 after a battle with cancer.

Tony was born in Salt Lake City on November 11, 1936 to Anton T. Clawson and Beth Rieben Clawson. He attended West High School and the University of Utah, graduating with a degree in Mathematics. He spent his career in the commercial printing industry, first as owner of Impressions, Inc. and then as Director of Printing Services at the University of Utah from 1980 until 1999.

Tony enjoyed many adventures with friends, including canoeing, river rafting, hiking, back-packing, biking, cross country skiing and fishing. His adventures included flying his Cessna 180 to Alaska, running four major rivers in the Northwest Territories, travels to the Arctic and Antarctica, biking across Iowa and boating and fishing in Alaska.
