Our beloved husband, father and friend, Jon P. Leatham returned to his heavenly home on May 26, 2017 at age 77, when recovering after surgery. He was born to Louis Salisbury Leatham and Anna Grace Carn on May 28, 1939, in Salt Lake City, Utah. He served as a missionary in the North British mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He married Susan Jane Lloyd on August 18, 1965 in the Salt Lake City LDS temple. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology and Entomology from The University of Utah. He served for a time in the Utah National Guard. He worked for The Division of Wildlife Resources as a biologist and then after retiring, he worked at Fisher Co., Shamrock Plumbing and Dual Creek Irrigation Co. He was also an ordinance worker in the Bountiful LDS temple for many years. He served in whatever calling was assigned to him in The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, one of his favorites being teaching primary children. His most favorite pastime was hunting. The bowhunt was an annual adventure he enjoyed with friends. He had an interest in drawing birds and he enjoyed reading historical fiction and other books. Most of the time, you would find him outdoors enjoying the mountains and beautiful creations around him.
