Judith Ann Ellis Steed passed away on Thursday, December 20, 2018 in the comfort of her home and with family at her side. She was born on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1948 in Salt Lake City to John Henry Ellis and Wanda Letitia Larson. Judith graduated from Davis High School and attended Brigham Young University, where she studied Speech Therapy.

Judith was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, and held positions in the Relief Society and Young Women presidency. On June 20th, 1969 she married the love of her life for time and all eternity in the Salt Lake City temple. Judith and Steven would have celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary this coming spring. They returned to Utah to raise their family in Salt Lake City, and later settled in her childhood city of Farmington.
