Layne Daryl Williams passed away at his home in Salt Lake City on September 22, 2015, at the age of 44, after battling cancer for over three years. Layne was born on September 20, 1971 in San Jose, California to Daryl and Carol Williams. He grew up in Concord, California. He has one brother, Jeffery, and two sisters, Keri Dee and Jenifer. Layne was a lifelong member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He served a mission for the Church in Norway.
