Chris's personality was reflected in his infectious smile, and he was a favorite amongst his classmates at Highland High School and in his job at Costco.

Chris demonstrated determination in the face of overwhelming pain, and his family and friends would like to express their love and admiration for his strength. His contagious presence will be missed by far more than he ever knew. Chris was a champion of raising awareness, and in his struggle with personal tragedy which ultimately took his life, he would want to leave this comfort with his loved ones: "In life there are going to be some things that make it hard to smile.
