Max Stark Larkin, age 94, passed away January 3, 2014, in Salt Lake City. He was born April 23, 1919, in Salt Lake to Alma James and Nellie Jane Stark Larkin. He married Farey Beth "Bettye" McClure on September 25, 1939; later solemnized in the Salt Lake Temple.

He graduated from East High School and LDS Business College. He started his career at Larkin Mortuary, the family business, when he was just a teenager.
