David Allan Watts (91) passed away peacefully at his home on Thursday, October 18, 2018 due to incidents related to his age. He graduated from San Rafael High School in San Rafael, California in 1945. Dave loved all sports. In high school, he played baseball, basketball, and football. He was the football captain his senior year. After graduation, Dave enlisted in the US Navy and served two years as a corpsman. He was discharged in 1947.

Dave married the love of his life, Rosemarie Haywood, on August 3, 1947 in Kentfield, California. They are the parents of six children, two girls (Kathleen and Sandra) and four boys (Richard, Donald, Neil and David). Dave attended two years at the College of Marin in Kentfield, California. Dave retired as a pipe fitter in 1990 in Concord, California. After retiring, Dave and Rosemarie moved to Sandy, Utah where they have lived for the past twenty eight years.
