Melva White, age 90, passed away on January 3, 2018 after gracefully battling the devastating grips of dementia for several years.

She cherished children, especially her 6 grandchildren (JD (Nikki), Jordan (Kristen), Sara (Kelly), Zach (Jenn), Adam and Kristie) and 3 great-grandchildren (Noelle, Jacob, and Lana) who always caused her to light up. Her favorite things were having the whole family together, cheering on her kids and grandkids at whatever they were doing, her home, the color red and the Utah Utes, and sitting outside in the sunshine.
