On August first, beloved husband and father, Richard Desmond Dickson peacefully passed away, as the result of multiple strokes. Richard was born in Salt Lake City, Utah on September 20, 1931 to Lyle D. and Twila Dickson. Richard grew up in Salt Lake City and graduated from Granite High.
