Beloved Dad, Gramps, and Great-Grandpa passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family on December 26, 2015. He was born April 30, 1930 in Salt Lake City, Utah to Charles Albert Harker and Ella Maud Parker. He graduated from Davis High School in 1948. He was a Korean War Veteran from 1951 to 1953 serving his country in the Army Security Agency 351st Communication Reconnaissance Company. Dad married his sweetheart Margaret Ann Anderson November 27, 1953, later sealed in the Salt Lake Temple. She preceded him in death and he is now joyfully reunited with her and son Chuck. He was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

In his younger days he played on championship baseball, basketball and fast-pitch softball teams, receiving MVP honors. He was also proud of winning two All-Church Fast-Pitch Softball Championships.

Survived by his daughters, Diane (Kyle) Memmott, Karen (Vaughn) Argyle, Kristine (Saimone) Katoa, and Terri (Ken) Culmone, and daughter-in-law Tracy (Darryl) Sanford, fourteen grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren.
