Our loving father, brother, grandfather and great-grandfather, John Q. Midgley passed away on August 5, 2017 at the age of 89 from complications of a stroke. John was born on March 13, 1928 in Salt Lake City to Donald Thomas and Hazel Midgley. He married Lois Mae Johnson on July 9, 1951 in the Salt Lake LDS Temple. He served faithfully in the LDS Church throughout his life, serving in the Western States Mission from 1949 , 1951 and with his loving wife in the England London South Mission in 1991.
