Our beloved mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister and friend, Diane Hurst, 87, passed away on November 22, 2017. She was born February 27, 1930 in Murray, Utah to Archie Lewis Tripp and Nellie Opal Gene Booth Tripp.

Diane was raised in Salt Lake City and graduated from East High School. She attended the University of Utah where she met Donald Hurst, her husband and partner of 67 years. She was an avid reader and organized a book club so she could share the experience and enjoy lively discussions.
