Their home became a base of love, strength, and faith — because superheroes don't fight alone. And with God as their source of power, they never gave up. Not once.

AJ was gentle, funny, caring, and strong. He taught us that true heroism isn't found in flying, swinging from buildings, or wearing a mask... It's found in love, bravery, and a heart that keeps fighting.
