Christmas and Thanksgiving gatherings were always a great time, she would prepare an amazing meal and then spend the whole night serving the food and cleaning dishes and not stopping to eat herself. Alta loved the great outdoors, you would often find her and Gene joining their kids and grandkids in camping adventures, Fishlake, Flaming Gorge, Island Park, the Uintahs. Alta was a devout member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints and loved serving in the temple.
