



## Anna Bauer Schulz

*Sept. 5, 1925 ~ May 28, 2022*

Anna Bauer Schulz peacefully passed away at home during the morning of May 28, 2022, at the age of 96. She was born on September 5, 1925 to Philipp and Luise Wilhelmine Kuhn Bauer in the town of Rohrful-Glasow, Pomerania, Germany. Anna married Jurgen Schulz in Celle, Germany in 1947 and were married for 63 years when he passed away in 2010. They were blessed to have a son, Joerg, while they were living in Celle. Several years later, in 1958, they moved to Utah to join other family members who had relocated after the War. They lived for many years in Salt Lake City Avenues area, Holladay, and finally for the past 27 years in Sandy.

Although Anna struggled with many health concerns throughout her life - Parkinson's disease, two heart attacks by her 40s, colon cancer, and lung and heart problems - she continued living each day to its fullest. Throughout her life, Anna was a faithful member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and truly loved the members of her ward. She loved spending her time gardening, cooking, entertaining friends and family, and traveling throughout the United States, Hawaii, Europe, Canada and Mexico. However, nothing brought her more joy than spending any time she could with her grandchildren, Kelby and Brianna and also her great-grandchildren, Alta and Leon.

The past few years have been difficult for Anna's health. She mainly stayed home with her son Joerg and her grandson, Kelby, watching the Utah Jazz play along with endless re-runs of "Everybody Loves Raymond". During the last couple of weeks of Anna's life, her health rapidly declined and was on hospice care. Our family would like to thank Rocky Mountain Hospice for providing her with great care during this difficult time. Anna had a profound impact on the lives of everyone she knew - she will be greatly missed by all of those who were blessed to know her.
