Ardith, our loving mother, grandmother and great grandmother, passed away peacefully Sunday morning in Bountiful, Utah at Oakridge of Bountiful Care Facility with family by her side, September 4, 2022, at the age of 91. She joins her husband Bill who passed away in 1983.

Ardith (Ardie) was born July 8th, 1931 in Ogden, Utah to Herman and Montana Richards. She was the second oldest of 6 children. She and her siblings loved spending time together singing. She and her brother Doug, would sing at many church and family events. She spent most of her early years in Provo; graduating from Lincoln High School and then attending Brigham Young University. She met and married William Melvin Moore on November 25, 1949. They raised their family in Cottonwood Heights and were blessed with three children; Michael William, MaryEllen and Kelly Lynn.

Ardie enjoyed being a hardworking stay-at-home Mom for many years while working part time as a seamstress for local choir groups. She was also a very gifted musician and spent a lot of her time at the piano; playing and leading church choir groups. She loved being a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and using her musical talents to bless the lives of others. She and Bill loved the outdoors; fishing and camping together. They even developed a talent for archery and were both State champions. After her youngest daughter was born, she went back to work outside of the home at Valley Bank and Trust and worked there for 20 years as a loan officer. She then worked at the University of Utah in the

College of Nursing as their receptionist where she loved getting toknow the young nursing students. Later in life, she served with the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers.

She lost her dear husband Bill in 1983 at 54 to cancer. Ten years after Bill died, she married LeRoy Sauter. She enjoyed living in Graystone Condos in Sugarhouse where she made many friends. She and LeRoy enjoyed playing golf at the Alpine Country Club, playing the piano and doing sewing projects together. She loved her ward where she was the ward organist. After 20 years, she and LeRoy divorced and went their separate ways. She spent the

past 6 years at Oakridge of Bountiful Care Facility (previously called Waikoloa). She used her talents there to play piano for church and singing events. She loved to laugh and joke with the ladies she met there and really came to love the caregivers who went out of their way every day.

Ardith will be greatly missed. She will be remembered as independent, determined, a woman of many talents, and a loving

mother. We will always treasure her memory; with a song in our hearts.
