



## Bartlett "Bart" Edward Paskins

We are heartbroken to announce that Bartlett "Bart" Edward Paskins passed away at age 83 on December 6, 2022 from complications from surgery in Sandy, Utah. He was born May 23, 1939 to Edward "Ted" Alonzo Paskins and Celia Johnson Paskins in Preston, Idaho. He lived his childhood in Treasureton, Idaho. He attended Preston High School and immediately joined the Air Force. Bart was stationed in South Korea at the end of the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1962.

Bart met the love of his life, Carolyn Howell Paskins, and they married on March 24, 1961. Later that year, they welcomed their first daughter Sheri, and 5 ½ years later, Heidi was born. Bart was the best girl-dad ever. They bought their first home in Sandy, Utah in the early 1970s, and he lived there independently his entire life.

Bart had a love of old cars and spent many weekends roaming old car shows. He also enjoyed golfing with his brother Kent Paskins and brother-in-law Jay Christensen and spent long lunches with family together after golf.

Bart loved traveling with his family and spending days on the boat at The Great Salt Lake, Flaming Gorge and Lake Powell. He never turned down an opportunity to join his family on an adventure. He spent many trips in Jackson Hole, Yellowstone, Bear Lake, Idaho, California, Hawaii, Mexico, and more, making memories with his family. His greatest joy was getting together with family for birthdays and holidays, and his phone was full of happy pictures and videos of all his favorite people.

He had an incredible work ethic that he passed on to his daughters and grandkids. He worked for American Linen (ALSCO) for 54 year and retired in his early 70s. He was fair and honest in all of his dealings. He loved keeping in touch with his work buddies and enjoyed monthly luncheons where they would spend hours talking about the good old days.

He adored his sweet neighbors who frequently included him in their backyard barbeques and always kept an eye on him for his family. We thank them from the bottom of our hearts for the love and care they showed our father.

Bart was charming and had a great personality. He was fun and friendly to everyone. He could make you smile with a joke or a touch of sarcasm. He was fair and honest in all of his dealings, and he always treated others like he wanted to be treated.

Bart is survived by daughters Sheri (Michael Scheuer) Paskins and Heidi (Troy) Bean; grandchildren Chelsea (Landen) Curtis, Gerrett (Tori) Pitkin, Preston Bean, Tessa (Harrison Conway) Scheuer, and Caitlin (Guy Watson) Scheuer; and 6 great grandchildren.
