Bernard Howard Starkey passed away at home, surrounded by family, on October 1, 2024. He was born on April 26, 1934, in Hinsdale, NH, to Myrtle and William Starkey and was one of six children.

After his parents passed away when he was a very young boy, he lived with several families while growing up but retained fond memories of his childhood. After graduating high school, he joined the Air Force, where he served for four years. Shortly after, he met the love of his life, Idella Taylor. They were married in 1956 in Pontiac, MI, and sealed in the LDS temple shortly thereafter. They were married for 59 years until her death in 2016.
