At age 17, Liz began her career as a fashion designer. At 18 she had her first centerfold in Harper's Bazaar. Liz married Marvin Edward Grandlinger on June 3, 1955, in Glendale, California. Marvin passed away in 2009. Liz continued in the fashion industry until she was 89. She also worked as an actress in films such as Executioner's Song, and Takedown. Using her creativity, she started her painting career at the age of 70 and painted until the end of her life.

Liz will be missed by all those whose lives she touched. Liz was so lively and energetic that her daughter gave her the nickname "my Energizer Bunny."
