



## Catherine Louise Thody

*August 14, 1949 ~ April 30, 2023*

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of our beloved aunt and sister, Catherine Louise Thody, who passed away peacefully in Chandler Arizona, on April 30, 2023, from complications related to COPD. She was 73 years old. Born in Los Angeles on August 14, 1949, she was raised in San Marino, California. She was always eager to share her knowledge and love of her family with anyone who showed an interest. Cathie loved holidays, especially her birthday, which she would anticipate and celebrate with great joy and enthusiasm.

Cathie is survived by her sister, Juliet Thody Curtis (L. David), 10 nieces and nephews, and 31 great nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, Gertrude Neslen Thody Bennion and William Alan Thody, stepfather Adam Y. Bennion, brothers Louis Alan (Ladd) Thody and William Alan (Billy) Thody Jr. , and sister Jane Thody Breinholt (Robert H.).
