In Provo, on the morning of May 2, 2020, Tavia Lee Draney Woolley Franson and Ethan Rex Franson welcomed their eldest son, Watson, into the world. Immediately after his arrival, Watson wowed physicians, nurses, and family when he recovered from emergency resuscitation and looked out bright-eyed and triumphant. His indomitable spirit radiated far beyond the confines of his 4 pound, 15-ounce frame.

During his 10 days in mortality, Watson enthusiastically embraced every new experience. Despite the frailty of his condition, Watson played with every cord, pulled every tube, grasped every hand, tasted everything within reach, and won the heart of every NICU nurse. His handsome black eyes looked upon his parents with pure adoration: evidence of a bond that surpasses the veils of time and space.

After being embraced by his grandmothers and grandfathers, Watson laid securely in the arms of his devoted parents until his passing on May 11, 2020.
