Nyle Keith Walton of Salt Lake City passed away from natural causes on May 24, 2016. He was born in Salt Lake City on October 10, 1933 to Ivan R and Jean Thomander Walton. When he was 14 he read a book written by Richard Halliburton that inspired him to hitch hike around the world. He started at 16, hitch hiking to Mexico City with a friend. He graduated from South High School, Class of 1951. He joined the Army in 1954 and was stationed in Europe to continue his adventures.
