Darlyne Wells, age 89, passed away peacefully in her home in Sandy, Utah on February 9, 2025.

As a devoted member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints Darlyne held many leadership roles including Relief Society President, Young Women President, Primary President and teacher in each of these organizations.
