Darrell Mills Barnes was born 29 March 1926, Salt Lake City to Royal Kenneth Barnes and Fanny Mills Barnes. He died on 14 April 2022 at the age of 96.

Darrell was part of the Greatest Generation growing up during the Depression, World War II and the Big Band Era. He had fond memories of his youth on Princeton Avenue in Salt Lake with his older brother Kenneth, little sister Joan and many friends. He enjoyed playing football at East High, upon graduating he volunteered for military service during World War II and earned the rank of Sargent as a gunner on a B-24 Bomber.
