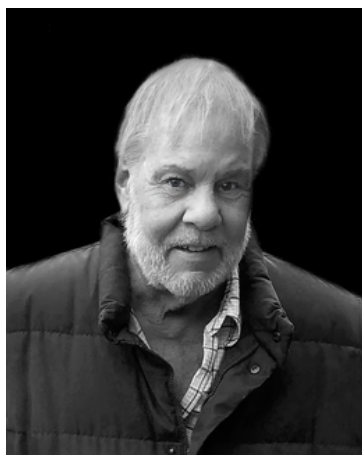




David (Dave) Mack Horne Jr.
