Dawnell was very smart and proudly earned her master's degree from Western Governors University. She was incredibly detail-oriented, hardworking and organized—traits that helped her excel during her schooling and throughout her career.

She inherited her dad's love for motorcycles and was a proud two-time NHHA champion. She made numerous, lifelong friends, local and national, within the desert Hare and Hound racing community. When she retired from desert racing, she moved onto an Indian road cruiser where she enjoyed long mountain rides with her dad, uncle Kerry, cousin Chaz, and others.
