



## Dennis “Lynn” Kemp

Our loving Husband, Father, Grandfather, Great-Grandfather, Brother, and Friend passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 5, 2021, with his wife of 60 years by his side.

Born August 2, 1941, in Murray, Utah to Daniel Arthur Kemp and Verona Sizemore Kemp. Lynn was the only son of 4 children. He lost his father at the young age of 18 and continued to take care of the family farm for most of his life, until the property was sold.

In his retirement, Lynn enjoyed listening to old-school country music, watching western movies, working in his beautiful yard, fishing and supporting his favorite team, the Utah Jazz. He loved being surrounded by his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren and spent every day with his loving wife.
