



Dona (Donna) Brinton Buckmiller

The much loved and admired by her family, Donna (Dona) Brinton Buckmiller, was born in Salt Lake City, to Donald Guy Brinton and Alta Myrle Allen Brinton, January 15, 1925, and passed away at her home, October 20, 2022, in Salt Lake City. She was 97 years old. Her parents, her three sisters, her husband, and her sons-in-law preceded her in death.
