He found happiness in life's simple pleasures: enjoying Mexican food, soaking up warm weather, spending time with his family, and doting on the family dogs. He shared a special bond with his beloved "Puppy Boy," Maximus, and we find comfort knowing they are reunited in heaven once again.

Kurt is survived by his devoted wife, Jo Annie; his children, Mandy, Sean, and Lacy (Lumpers) and her husband, Ben; his cherished grandchildren, CJ, Theo, and Kylie; his loving parents, Don and Claudia; and his beloved grandpups, Bonnie and Henry.
