Dr. Nancy Pedersen Lunnen passed away peacefully in Ogden, Utah at the age of 89 surrounded by family. You could always catch her spending countless hours of free time learning and playing different songs on the piano. Her talent for writing enabled her to publish two fictional children's books. She loved to travel and see new places, however, the moments she had at home with her family and many pets were the times that she valued the most.
