Janet Young Hammond died May 19, 2018 in Salt Lake City, Utah at age 86. She was born on February 11, 1932 to Dow Harold Young and Effay VanCott Young. Janet married her eternal companion, Harlan Young Hammond on December 22, 1952 in the Salt Lake Temple. He preceded her in death.
