Elaine Nelson Sorensen 92, returned to her Heavenly Father on March 16, 2023. Elaine was born on March 22, 1930, to Christian Vinson and Thelma Bostrom Nelson in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Elaine and Arlin were blessed with the opportunity to adopt 3 wonderful children, Richard Bruce, Teresa Lynn, and Scott Douglas Sorensen. While serving in the Air Force, they had the opportunity to live in many different places around the world, including being stationed in Germany, France, and several bases in the United States.
