Elizabeth Ellen Bell Lee, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and friend, passed away peacefully on May 26, 2025, at the age of 90. Born on March 21, 1935, in Castle Dale, Utah, Elizabeth was one of seven daughters of Andrew and Zada Bell. From an early age, she displayed a love of reading that would stay with her throughout her life. Elizabeth graduated from high school and pursued her passion for caring for others by earning her Registered Nurse (RN) degree from Westminster College in Salt Lake City, Utah. Her career in nursing was not only a calling but also the beginning of her greatest love story—she met her future husband, Harlee A. Lee, when he became her patient. For Harlee, it was love at first sight, and their bond quickly blossomed.
