*Jan. 20, 1943 ~ July 17, 2021*

Our loving wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, Ellen Louise Coombs Shaw, age 78, died peacefully on July 17, 2021, at home with her family by her side in Murray, UT. She is now free from her physical pains and cruel effects of Posterior Cortical Atrophy (PCA), a rare form of Alzheimer's/Dementia.

You never doubted how she felt about you because she continually told you how much she loved you and would give the biggest hugs. She loved her 13 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren so much. Most of them remember grandma for saying "I love you the most and I said it first". It was always a race to see if grandma or the grandkids would get it out first and then she would follow with a "darn your socks". She was the most kind, sweet, selfless person in the world and had the most beautiful smile that we will miss so much. Things that will remind us all of her are her love of purple (including her purple hair), John Wayne movies, old musicals, annual trips to Tuacahn, and her fun sense of humor.

Ellen is survived by her husband of 56 years, Deloy, her 5 daughters Sherri (Jeff), Shelli (Mat), Sheila (Justin), Sheryn (Troy), and Kathi (Randy), as well as 13 grandchildren – Heather, Kyle (Shelbi), Shawn, Austin, Makayla (Cody), Shay (Casey), Wyatt (Jayde), Summer (Trevor), Layne (Shoni), Sheyenne (Jacob), Sierra, Shelby, Brooke (Zach) and 6 great-grandchildren – Scarlett, KJ, Ila, Autumn, Avery, and another arriving next month.
