Emily Bethe Baldwin Visick died peacefully May 23, 2022 in Logan, Utah, following several years of battling the effects of a stroke. Bethe was born June 9, 1929 in Monroe, Utah, the daughter of Emily Wilhelmina Bohman and James Hyrum Baldwin. She earned degrees from the College of Southern Utah and Brigham Young University in English and Education. Bethe worked as a junior-high English teacher, in the Utah National Parks, and in secretarial roles for Western Airlines and later for the Bureau of Reclamation's Lower Colorado Division.

Bethe loved literature, art, and music, but most greatly valued her family and friends. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, and especially friend. She was preceded in death by her sister Beverly Baldwin Lowe and three half-brothers.
