Fred K Hubert passed away in Salt Lake City, on November 26th, 2022. Born April 5th, 1930 to father, Kurt Karl Hubert, and mother, Emilie Martha Schmidt-Hubert. Fred grew up in a German-American household, where piano and song often filled the air.
