On March 25th, 2025, Grand Master Gary Lee Cox passed away peacefully in his sleep.

Gary served in the military as a member of the National Guard, Paratroopers, and the Special Forces as a Green Beret for over 10 years.

Before finding his passion in martial arts, he owned his own restaurant, an Irish sandwich shop called Magilacutty's. Gary ran his own martial arts studio with his wife and son for over 50 years.
