Hary Alberto Viana, 84, died peacefully in his sleep on February 14, 2023, in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Alberto was born on February 9, 1939, in Minas de Corrales, Uruguay to Juan Viana and Edelma Rodríguez. He studied history and philosophy in Montevideo, two of his favorite academic subjects, in hopes of becoming a teacher.
