Herman Charles Branath, age 93 passed away May 11th, 2021 in Sandy, Utah from natural causes.

Herman Branath was born July 19, 1927 in Nyack, New York. He attended high school in Nyack, New York and later enlisted in the Army at the age of 18 as a tank driver where he received a purple heart and bronze star. After returning from military service, he attended school at New York State College.

As a youth Herman was a member of the Boy Scouts and later served as a scout leader. He served as chaplain for the Empire H&L volunteer fire department.

Herman married Marilynn Branath in September of 1984 with whom he enjoyed extensive travelling and many outdoor activities.
