On Monday December 5, 2022, James Ross Anderson, beloved husband and father passed away. Jim was 75 years old.

Jim graduated from the University of Utah with a bachelor's degree in Business Management. Jim ended his career as a Captain for Unified Fire Authority in 2009 having mentored countless new firefighters and paramedics over his career, many who are still shooting for the blue dot.
