Terry Kidd was a remarkable man. A gentle man, he approached life with patience, kindness and good humor. He passed away on 1 September 2022 after a long battle with Alzheimer's, surrounded by family.

James Terry Kidd was born 21 January 1943 in St. Anthony, Idaho, to Austin Fern and Mary Elizabeth Davidson Kidd. The third of nine children, Dad spent his youth in Ashton, Idaho, and graduated from Pocatello High School. He married the love of his life, Gloria Wickham, in the Logan Utah Temple in 1970 and was the proud father of six children. He had a great love for his family, both immediate and extended; he looked forward with eagerness to annual family reunions and was happiest spending time with his kids and grandkids.

Dad loved to learn and believed a successful life was equal parts work and play. He received a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics from Utah State University, and a Master of Arts degree in Mathematics Education from Johns Hopkins University. His many different career endeavors ranged from teaching high school and college math to owning and operating his own small business. When not working, Dad loved music and he loved John Denver. Some of our favorite memories are of Dad playing his guitar for family sing-alongs. He also loved playing games, enjoying nature, and playing disc golf, always with family close by.

Dad was a devoted member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and was stalwart in his faith. He served as a church missionary in Southern California and was proud of the missionary service performed by his sons, sons-in law and grandchildren. He attended the temple often when he was able and taught his children to love the temple for the connections it made with family on both sides of the veil.

Terry is survived by Gloria, his wife of 52 years; his children: Brandon (Stacie); Tiffani (Jared) Wandell; Jeremy (Heather); Chelsi (Ben) Kroff; Tyler (Katie); John Cameron (Cassie); 22 grandchildren and one great-grandchild, as well as two sisters and four brothers. He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, and a sister.
