Jason Michael Becker's love for life didn't come to an end with his death. Jason passed away the morning of March 1, 2023 at the age of 45 after a valiant yearlong battle with ALS, surrounded by loved ones who will continue to honor his legacy by living their lives to the fullest.

On his days off, Jason loved to do woodwork, rebuild cars, do landscaping, and explore local campgrounds with his family. Jason was blessed to find Emily, his equal partner and the perfect person with which to play, work, and share these simple pleasures. He considered his daughters to be his greatest accomplishment.

Jason was preceded in death by his father, Gary. He is survived by his wife, Emily; two daughters, Lily (Caden) and Sadie Rose; his mother, Luann; his siblings, Jamie (Julie) Becker and Kristin (Brad) Hadin; as well as 14 nephews and 5 nieces.
