Our beautiful wife, mother, grandmother, and dear friend, Joan Middaugh Miller, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, April 18, 2024. She leaves behind a legacy of a wholehearted faith in Christ and an unbounded love for all.

Due to John's career success, he was transferred to many states some of them being Wyoming, Colorado, Nevada, North Dakota, Oklahoma, and California.
