John Odell Tolman passed away Sunday, March 5, 2023 in Cottonwood Heights, Utah. He was born January 11, 1935 in Pocatello, Idaho to William Odell and Opal Adams Tolman, the oldest of seven children. He graduated from Idaho Falls High School in 1953 and fulfilled a mission for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (1955-1957) to the Northern California Mission.

John married Dixie Selby in the Salt Lake Temple in 1957 and they were blessed with 3 children: Stephen (Jan), Leah (David) Durr, Derek (Carolyn). In 1968, he married Joan Ranck in the Salt Lake Temple and added 2 children from her previous marriage, whom he legally adopted: Kathryn (Douglas) Jones, and Todd (Linda). He enjoyed his opportunities for service in his ward and stake and especially enjoyed teaching the Gospel Doctrine Class. He also served in 3 temples - Jordan River, Palmyra, and Salt Lake, and enjoyed serving a mission with his wife, Joan, in the New York, Rochester Mission. His love of the Prophet Joseph Smith made serving in the Cradle of the Restoration a high point in his life.
