Julie was a fabulous cook and she welcomed many in her home for fabulous feasts, especially on holidays. She loved to line dance with Terry and did so weekly, until she physically could not continue to do so. She also served in the temple weekly until the progression of her husband's Alzheimer's required her to stay home and care for him. After his passing she returned to faithful temple service until her own dementia prevented her from participating.
